Food and Alcohol

Purchases for floor events, including mandatory Holiday event in December

Child Basement: \$115 per term

Child 1-4, Richards, Conant: \$225 per term

Perkins: \$435 per term

Kitchen Supplies

Purchases of communal kitchen items (and coffee/tea) for the floor to use during the year

Child, Richards, and Conant: \$50

Perkins: \$100

Special Funding

Funding supplied for situational expenses

- **Custodial Breakfasts:**
Each Hall: \$25
- **Social Events** (To be used for both the Halloween and Valentine's Day Parties): \$400
- **Focus Areas:**
 - Communications Liaison:** \$50
 - English as a Foreign Language:** \$100
 - Environmental Representative:** \$250
 - Liaison for Gay, Lesbian, Bisexual, Transgender Student Concerns:** \$150
 - Sexual Assault and Sexual Harassment (SASH) Representatives:** \$100
 - Wellness Representative:** \$150
- **RA Evaluations Winnings**
Each term, one floor per resident hall with the majority of resident responses (and all floors with unanimous responses) will receive:
 - Child Basement:** \$30 or **Child Hall 1-4:** \$50
 - Richards and Conant:** \$50
 - Perkins:** \$100
- **Contest Winnings** (eg Sustainability)
Winning floors will be awarded either \$25 or \$50 based on their response rates and number of residents

- **Welcome Events Purchases** (eg Brownie Bake)
Specific Welcome Events (events promoted on the Welcome the Res Hall website for all residents) will receive funding if pre-approved by Res Life office
